All faculty members cover full syllabus timely. Students are also provided subject related material through WhatsApp group and LMS platforms.

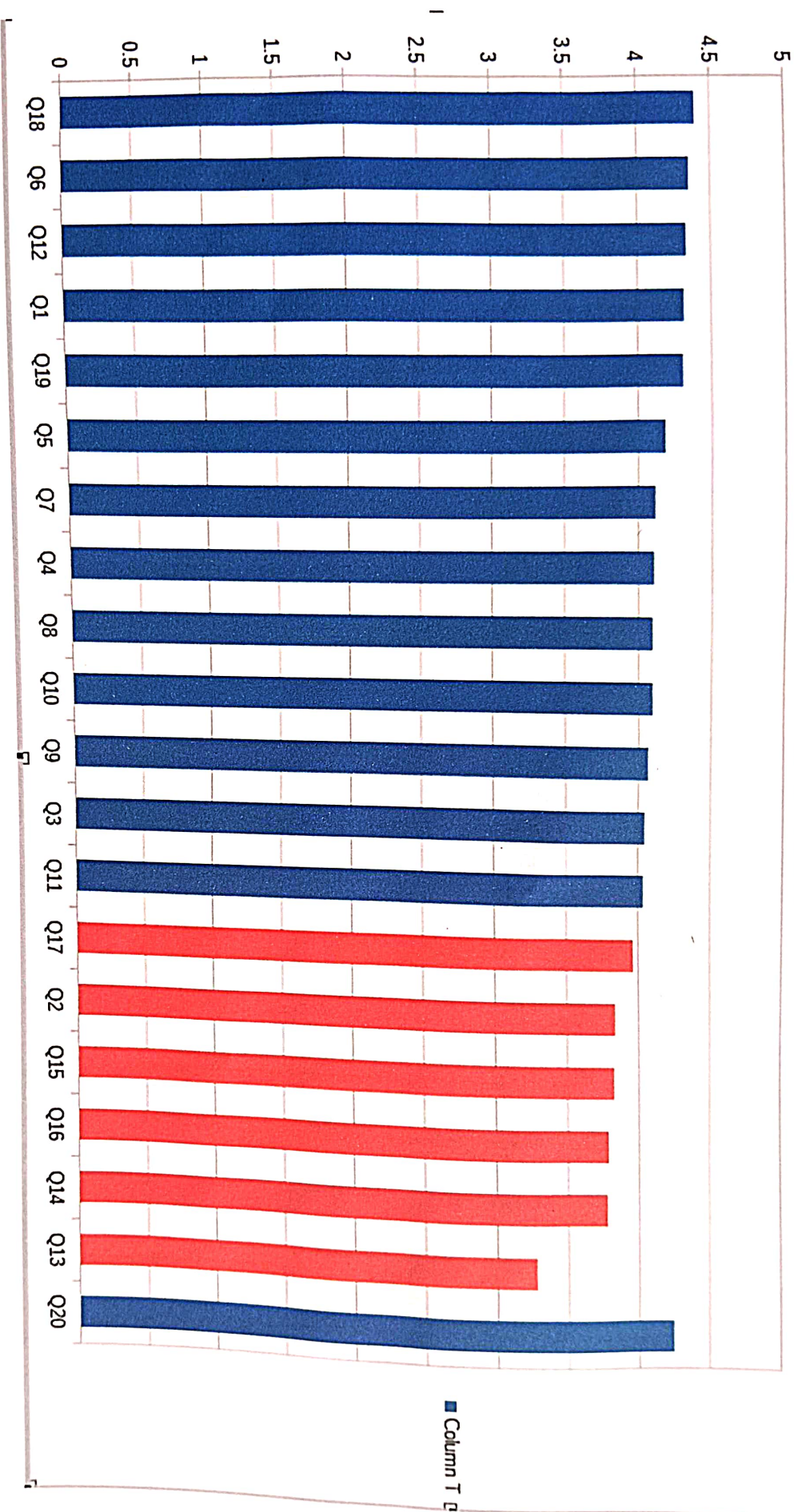


