









Note:

- Teacher-Educators who have been allotted two Internship Schools should ensure equal presence in the schools throughout the Internship (Phase-I).
- Any student-teacher found misbehaving with staff members of concerned school, students or teacher educator shall be debarred from internship programme immediately.

- The Teacher Educator is overall in-charge of the group of 10 to 15 student-teachers. He/she will work as a facilitator, provides guidance/supervision/consultation to student teachers of his/her concerned group time to time as per schedule during School Internship Programme (SIP) -I.
- The Teacher Educator will follow the Annual School Calendar and Time Table of concerned school for School Internship Programme (SIP) -I.
- The Teacher-Educator will ensure his/her Biometric Attendance right throughout the first Phase of SIP (2024-26).
- The Teacher-Educator will regularly visit the allotted schools as per schedule and co-ordinate with the respective school head and staff.
- No request for change of allotted school by Student-Teachers shall be entertained in any case.
- The Teacher-Educator will maintain the attendance records/leave records of all student teachers of his/her group separately and also shall ensure minimum 90% attendance of student-teachers to appear in Final Evaluation/Examination in SIP (1).
- All types of activities/records/reports etc. which are maintained by the student teachers in SIP (1) will be certified by the Group In-charge, Head of the Institution, and Mentor-Teacher jointly.


In alignment with the directive from the National AIDS Control Organization (NACO), each RRC has to adopt a village or slum in their vicinity to further strengthen HIV/STI awareness initiative. This initiative is aimed at mobilizing and empowering RRC youth volunteers to engage with the rural youth community members in awareness activities, thereby bridging the information gap and enhancing access to HIV prevention, testing and related health services.

The activities under this initiative to be conducted includes:

1. Formation of youth groups and conducting awareness sessions on HIV/STI and other relevant health topics.
2. Distribution of IEC (Information, Education and communication) materials and organizing community discussions.
3. Observation of key health days such as World AIDS Day & National Youth Day.
4. Mobilization of Community members for HIV testing and promotion of available health services.
5. Conducting street plays, community meetings & games to enhance community engagement.

It is therefore, requested to issue the necessary instructions to the colleges and educational institutions having the RRCs to take up this initiative of Adopting Village/Slums in the structure and coordinated manner. Reporting format is enclosed at Annexure-1.


